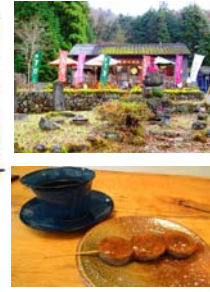
Attractions Map

- ① IWASAKU-Shrine (Shinto god in Takumi-Town. It's old and has a lot of stone monuments)
- ② Ishi-masu water supply (simple water supply made of natural stone. Completed in 1917 Now only 8 remained)
- ③ JYOUKO-JI-Temple (The temple has a lot of historic sites such as stone roofed gate, Jizo (small stone statue) and so on)
- ④ Jizo-bosatsu (small stone statue)
- ⑤ Stone park
- ⑥ The monument of the Emperor Taisho.
- ⑦ JIUN-Temple (Founded by the monk KOUKAI. Destroyed by the flood and restored in 1973.)
- ⑧ Lined Jizo (ghost-Jizo. Monk KOUKAI proposed to other monks and one hundred monks are enshrined each JIZO of their own. Only 74 are remain now because of the flood)
- ⑨ REIHIKAKU (Founded by the monk KOUKAI. He erected Fudo-stone statue, and he prayed with holy fire from the opposite riverside. The stone statue flowed out and restored in 1971.
- ⑩ Kobo-daishi (the great teacher) threw a writing brush. (It says Kobo-daishi carved words from an opposite riverside by throwing a writing brush)

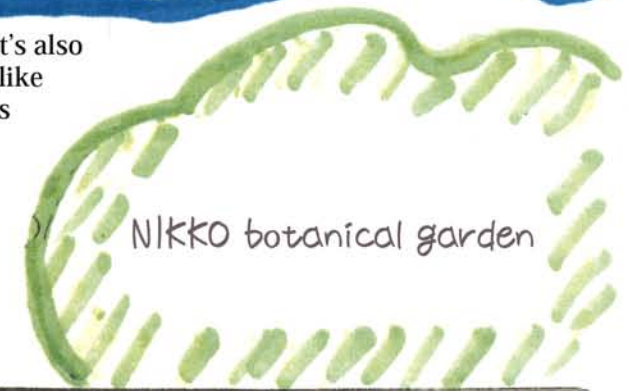
